Insider Guides Shopping

If you love shopping then you are going to fall in love with Dublin!
No matter where you go, you will never be far from temptation.
And the beauty of Dublin is that it is big enough to offer distinct shopping districts which are small enough to explore on foot!

Grafton Street and **Henry Street** are the main pedestrianised shopping thoroughfares. **Henry Street** offers the best choice in high street fashion and popular Irish chain stores and is where **Arnott's**, one of Dublin's best loved department stores, can be found.

Grafton Street provides the shopper with a myriad of temptations from the best of Irish and international fashion to Irish gifts and craft ware. There are many streets and lanes off Grafton Street to be explored where you will discover some hidden shopping delights. Suffolk Street is home to Avoca Handweavers, three floors of Irish fashion and gifts. Across the street is the Dublin Tourism Centre where you will find an array of traditional books, clothes and crafts.

Not to be missed is the **Powerscourt**Townhouse Centre, a beautifully restored Georgian Townhouse which houses specialised shops, galleries, antique jewellery stores and restaurants. On the third floor is **The Design**Centre, home to leading contemporary Irish and international labels offering you a unique choice of clothing. Nassau Street has a vast selection of Irish craft stores, such as the Kilkenny Design Centre and the House of Ireland which specialise in Irish design ware, glass, ceramics and more.

Once you leave the city behind many of the suburban shopping centres, such as **Liffey Valley Centre** and **Dundrum Town Centre**incorporate high-street favourites and speciality shops to provide a complete shopping experience under one roof.

For the more adventurous shoppers out there, **Dublin's** numerous markets are thriving and a wonderful way to spend a leisurely afternoon. **Blackrock Market** is one of the capital's gems and is a hugely successful weekend market. It boasts a unique blend of new, second-hand and antique goods as well as a broad range of fine and modern art, collectables, furniture and hand crafts

Another market on the must do list is **Cow's Lane Fashion & Design Market** in Temple Bar.

During the festive season the market will run every weekend from from the 1st to the 23rd

December. Featuring a wealth of once-off and unusual pieces from up and coming designers the wide ranging prices and styles will suit everyone's tastes and purses!

And not to forget any Christmas shopping you might want to fit in, the outdoor **Temple Bar Christmas Market** is a great place to pick up some of those last minute gifts! This festive bonanza will take place over 4 weekends in December from the 1st to the 23rd December in the magical open air spaces in the Old City



area of Temple Bar. The market will offer a diverse range of gift ideas with a variety of stalls selling crafts, jewellery, cards, gift wrap, photography, decorations, trees, prints, ceramics, toys and of course mulled wine and mince pies to keep you warm!

The annual Docklands Christmas Market "12 Days of Christmas Festival" takes place from December 12th to December 23rd, and promises to be a magical festive experience for families and shoppers alike. Vat Refunds: One of the best things about shopping in Ineland for non-EU visitors is that you are entitled to get a refund of VAT paid. There are three major refund systems – Global Refund, Tax Back or in-store refunds. The prime rule is that you have to get a VAT-refund form at the time of purchase from each store in which you shop. On leaving Ireland bring the completed form to the relevant Global Refund to Tax Back desk at the airport and they will organise a VAT refund to you.
